Helmed by twin brothers and directors Johnny and Paul Kember, KplusK began as a design company in London in 1984. Later, Johnny Kember relocated to Hong Kong, and KplusK was inaugurated in March 1996.

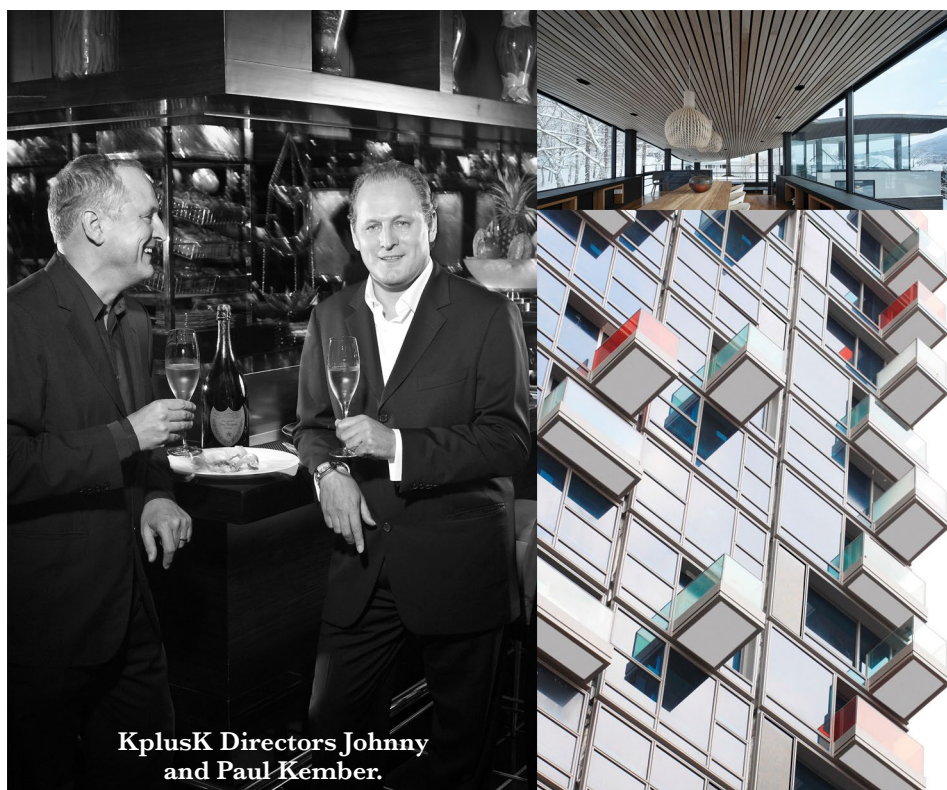
From Europe to Asia

The Kembers' keen eye for aesthetics owes to their training in architecture in the United Kingdom. Johnny gained his Masters degree in architecture at the Royal College of Art, London, while Paul received his Masters degree from the Bartlett School of Architecture in the University of London. Both have registered practice under charter to the Royal Institute of British Architects, and in their professional career, the Kembers also served as Assistant Professors of Architecture at the University of Hong Kong.

With this colourful background in architecture, KplusK has established itself as one of the leading architects in luxury residential, hotel and serviced apartment developments in Asia. With each masterfully designed project, the Kember brothers aim to create highly personalised environments, combining ergonomic and technological concerns – all without compromising the pursuit of a dynamic, heterogeneous, and sensual viscosity.

Setting the bar in luxury spaces

Designing with a mantra of “sensitivity in architecture”, the Kember brothers

also engage with issues of sustainability, energy efficiency and environmental responsibility. The directors incorporate and expand on these tenets into their beautifully crafted work.

KplusK's impressive portfolio of projects is all encompassing, spanning residential, hotels, serviced apartments, resorts, and cultural spaces, to clubbing and dining establishments, while master-planning some many iconic developments across Asia. These designs can be seen the world over, with the Kember brothers building a wealth of combined experience working in the Far East (Hong Kong, China, Taiwan, Thailand, Bali, Singapore, Macau and Malaysia), as well as in Europe (England, France, Italy, Sweden, Russia), Australia and the United States.

Under its belt, KplusK has won over 30 regional and international design

awards. Among them, 2013 Best Luxury Hotel Brand in Hong Kong for the Ovolo Hotel, CNN Travel for Best Villa Rental in South East Asia in 2012 for the Latitude Residence in Bali, and Best Architecture for the International Property Awards in 2009, established by CNBC and New York Times. With more projects underway and a team of 28 dedicated designers from eight different countries, KplusK remains a heavily sought out design studio boasting signature international quality. ■
